

Executive Board Officers' Duties:


Read the following list to see which office fits you.

- 4. **Treasurer**—responsible for financial aspects of the club, checking account and bank statements.
- 5. <u>Financial Director</u>—in charge of fundraising, coordinates Kick Off Party door prizes, Thank You letters to ad and door prize sponsors.
- 6. <u>Newsletter Editor</u>—gathers information at monthly Executive Board meetings, then organizes information and prepares the monthly newsletter, sends info to our web site.
- 7. <u>Communications Director</u>—in charge of all promotional work and publicity by media for Kick-Off Party, membership drives, fundraising, etc., and responsible for monthly web Calendar Page.
- 8. <u>Trustees</u> (4 elected)—attend the Executive Board meetings to offer opinions, learn the operation of the club, responsible for end of year audit of treasurer's records.


