

(in Ebensburg, 300 Prave Street, at the Trailhead of Ghost Town Trail)

...has a **rental program for cross-country ski equipment.** The rental program at the YPCC offers 12 pair of skis to accommodate ages 13 and up, 22 pair of ski poles of various sizes, and 14 pair of boots of various sizes. Rentals are now available per hour or for a full day. Hourly rate is \$8 adult (\$6 youth). Full day rate is \$32 adult (\$24 youth). Sections of the trail are groomed (with a track lane from Ebensburg to Nanty Glo). More info, call 814.472.4277 option 1.
