Executive Board Officers' Duties:

- 1. <u>President</u> oversees club functions and represents the club.
- 2. <u>Vice President</u> assists the President and is in charge of membership.
- 3. <u>Secretary</u> takes minutes at monthly Executive Board meetings, prepares Sign-up Sheets, and other club correspondence.
- 4. <u>Treasurer</u> responsible for financial aspects of the club, checking account and bank statements.
- 5. <u>Financial Director</u>—in charge of fundraising which includes 50/50 tickets, coordinates Kick Off Party door prizes, Thank You letters to ad and door prize sponsors.
- 6. <u>Newsletter Editor</u> gathers information at monthly Executive Board meetings, then organizes information and prepares the monthly newsletter, sends info to our web site.
- 7. <u>Communications Director</u> in charge of all promotional work and publicity by media for Kick Off Party, membership drives, fundraising, etc., and responsible for monthly web Calendar Page.
- 8. <u>Trustees</u> (4 elected) attend the Executive Board meetings to offer opinions, learn the operation of the club, responsible for end of year audit of treasurer's records.

The term runs from May 2023—May 2024. The Board meets once a month to plan and organize events. Officers are all expected to lead at least one event and assist with other events.

If this is something you are willing to do, then consider running for an office! We hope members will step up and run for an officer position. In being an officer, your membership dues are free that term.
